The max amount of volunteers needed for the day is 15-20. Volunteer registration is on a first come, first served basis. We will have a waitlist.

Important information:

Thank you for your interest in Habitat. We appreciate our volunteers! The age limit for the construction site is **16 years of age**. Please complete the Volunteer Registration and Waiver form.

On the construction site we ask that our volunteers arrive for **7:45am**. We start building at 8:00. We have a full time construction staff that will greet you on site to sign you in, give a brief safety meeting, explain the task for the day and answer any questions that you may have. We provide all the safety equipment and tools necessary.

This is a working construction site. Please pay close attention to the dress code that is explained on the Volunteer Information sheet. Steel-toed shoes or boots are optimal for the construction site. Thick soled shoes such as running shoes will suffice. **Slick dress shoes, thin soled running shoes, sandals, thongs, croc style (or other open toed shoes) and slippers are not allowed on the job site.** Shirts either long sleeve, short sleeve shirts and t-shirts are allowed. **Sleeveless shirts inclusive of tank tops, tube tops, spaghetti string tops, sports bras and halter tops are NOT allowed.** This dress code has been compiled by HFHGBR and OSHA standards. If the construction supervisor deems anything that you may be wearing as a safety hazard he/she will not allow you to work on the job site for your own personal safety.

We provide water, PowerAde and snacks. We do not provide a lunch (SGMP will provide lunch). Volunteers and groups pack a lunch and eat on site, or they may leave site for lunch. During the hotter months, it is recommended that you hydrate well starting the day before your build. If you take medications that interfere with hydration, be sure to take extra care in hydrating the day before, morning of and throughout the day. We usually start picking up at 2:30 and are finished between **3:00-3:30**.
